Granville Island Vancouver, B.C.

- 1972, a federal order-in-council assigned management of the 14-hectare site to Canadian Mortgage & Housing Corporation
- 38 Acre former sand flat "island' with nearly 750,000 Sf of mixed use development
- The federal government invested \$24.7 million there between 1973 and 1982.
- 1979, the federal and provincial governments converted a 50,000 square foot building to the Public Market.
- 1980, the Emily Carr University of Art & Design was added to the island.
- A 2040 plan to redevelop the island in being proposed in part because the Emily Carr University was going to move off the island.

- 400 acre island constructed in 1936-37 for the 1939 Golden Gate International Exhibition
- U.S. Navy took possession in 1942 to use as a major facility for embarkation to the Pacific theater
- 2010 Redevelopment plan with a master developer calls for;
 - 8,000 units of new housing
 - 240,000 of commercial space
 - 300 acres of new parks

Treasure Island San Francisco



Presidio San Francisco

- 1500 acre former U.S. Army Base Transferred land and buildings from Federal Government to Presidio Trust
- Capped development at 5.9mm SF
- Mission to become self-sufficient financially in 15 years
- Tri-party relationship with NPC and CCNC (Golden Gate Natural Conservancy)

Cavallo Point Fort Baker

- In 1866, the U.S. Army acquired the site for a military base to fortify the north side of the Golden Gate
- 24 buildings around the 10-acre parade ground were built between 1901 and 1915
- In 2002 Fort Baker transferred officially to NPS
- ECB and Passport Resorts was selected by the NPS to develop a 142 unit lodge and conference center
- The 200,000 square foot project includes 11,000 square feet of spa facilities, 15,000 square feet of meeting space, and a 90 seat restaurant
- Deal included \$40 million in equity, \$49 million in construction loans, and \$12 million in historic tax credit equity
